Welcome to the Pat Lid Pin Draw 4 of the 2019/20 Thursday Night Men's league. For those curlers who may be new to the club or to Thursday night, Thursday night is intended to be a fun night with a certain amount of competition thrown in. Teams are drawn up by lottery from among those wishing to curl and positions are determined by years of seniority of each curler. If you are wondering about your seniority please contact the Thursday night draw committee.

This draw runs for a 5 week period. A trophy and individual pins is associated with this draw, and the winner is determined by their points standing at the end of the draw. Trophies are awarded at the club's banquet May 4th.

The draw Committee has decided to continue the sparing rule change to improve your chances of getting spares. Spares will be allowed to play the position of the missing player up to and including third.

If for any reason, a scheduled game cannot be played at the designated time, the offending team will ask the Club Draw Chair for ice time for a make-up game. The make-up game must be completed by the end of the draw.

If the make-up game is not completed, the non-offending team will be awarded Default points. Also advise the Thursday Draw committee, Jeff Cumming or Niall Maclean, of all make-up games.

Scoring for points spiel format trophies:

Win	10 points
End	1 point for each end and 1/2 point for blank end (for first 6 ends), no points for extra end
Score	1/2 score (for first 6 ends) to a maximum of 5
Tie Game	Decided by extra end, one rock per player, played towards glass
Default	14 points to the non-offending team, 0 points to the offending team
